

Key Elements

- Weather monitoring
 - Assessing leaf moisture, relative humidity, temperature, and solar radiation to optimize farm management.
- Precision farming Improving efficiency of applications by using cuttingedge sprayers with GPS and low-drift nozzles.
- 3 Irrigation management
 Optimizing irrigation by using control tools such as tensiometric probes.
- Fertilization management
 Fulfilling the nutrient needs of crops through fertilizer management software such as Farmstar®.
- Soil analysis
 Conducting regular soil analysis to optimize organic and mineral fertilization, thereby preserving soil characteristics.
- Sowing practices
 Implementing best practices in sowing to minimize the risk of wildlife exposure to treated seeds.
- Protecting pollinators
 Welcoming beehives each spring and abiding by a charter of commitment for good agricultural and beekeeping practices.
- Biodiversity

 Taking inventory of and monitoring wildlife, such as birds, earthworms and beneficial insects, and taking measures to protect biodiversity, including planting hedges.
- Protected species
 Respecting good agricultural practices that protect the local bird species, Oedicnème Criard, nesting in the farm's corn.
- User safety
 Partnering with Bayer to optimize personal protective
- equipment during crop protection product application and storage to maximize safety and comfort.
- Wastewater management
 Designating a filling and rinsing station as well as installing the Phytobac® bioremediation system that ensures optimal on-farm wastewater management.
- Partnerships
 Bringing together experts and community members to foster dialogue on modern, sustainable farming.
