Dr. Fei-Fei Li is one of the most prominent Artificial Intelligence (AI) scholars in the USA with very broad interest, including healthcare. She possesses a deep digital knowledge due to her focus on AI, machine learning, computer vision, robotics, cognitive vision, cognitive neuroscience and computational neuroscience. Dr. Li is the inaugural Sequoia Professor in the Computer Science Department at Stanford University, and the Denning Co-Director of Stanford's Human-Centered AI Institute. During her sabbatical from Stanford University she was Vice President at Google and served as its Chief Scientist of AI and Machine Learning (ML) at Google Cloud from January 2017 to September 2018. In recent years, Dr. Li's research work expanded to AI and Healthcare, particularly on improving healthcare delivery. Since 2020 she has gained experience as a non-executive member of the Boards of Directors of listed US venture capital company Reinvent Technology Partners and Twitter. Besides, Dr. Li is a cofounder and Chairperson of the Board of AI4ALL, a nonprofit organization dedicated to increase diverse human representations in the field of AI and technology. Due to her significant contributions in AI, computer science and medicine, she is an elected member of the National Academy of Engineering, and the National Academy of Medicine.
