URGENT MEDICINE RECALL (CLASS II TYPE A)

Class II recall is intended for medicines that possibly could cause temporary or medically reversible adverse health problem or mistreatment.

Type A recall is designed to reach all suppliers of medicines (all distribution points) i.e., wholesalers, hospitals, retail pharmacy outlets, doctors, nurses, pharmacists, authorised prescribers and dispensers, and individual customers or patients

Reason for Recall:

This recall is initiated due to a limited number of packs found in retail Pharmacy, with mix-up of the sequence of hormone-containing and hormone-free tablets, wherein some packs had

- 24 light orange hormone-free, and
- 4 pink film-coated hormone tablets

Instead of

- 24 pink film-coated hormone tablets and
- 4 light orange hormone-free tablets.

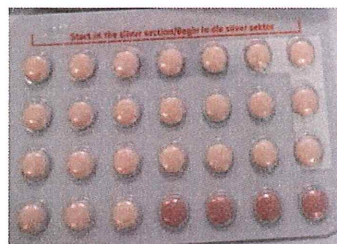

The defective packs contain only 4 hormone tablets instead of 24 hormone tablets and will not provide the expected contraceptive efficacy. A return to supplier of Batch WEW96J is recommended.

- Kindly retain this letter in a prominent position for one month, in case stock is still in transit.
